

# Seymour Tennis Complex

The Seymour Tennis Complex will be open to **club members only for social tennis and for coaching participants** until further notice and subject to the following conditions.

## **Health of Participants**

If you have been exposed to someone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days or have even mild flu-like symptoms then you must not attend the facility.

## **Number of Participants**

The maximum of 10 players are permitted to use the courts at any time.

## **Registration of Players**

All players must register before entering a court. This will be done by texting details of the players, phone contact number , and proposed time of play to Bruce Anderson on 0428 998 470.

## **Access to Courts**

Access to the courts will be via the combination lock on the main gate. Other gates to the courts will remain unlocked and open. The combination lock must be disinfected after each use. Disinfection wipes are provided for this purpose, and must be used after both opening and closing the lock.

## **Tennis Balls**

The Complex will not provide any tennis balls. Players must provide their own equipment and are responsible for its washing/sterilisation.

## **Social Distancing**

Keep 1.5 metres away from other people while taking part in a tennis activity. Remember no handshakes or High Fives, try tapping racquets instead.

## **Behaviours**

To protect against infection, you should:

- Wash/sterilise your hands before and after you play
- Avoid touching your face while playing.
- Not share water bottles and bring your own bottle, already full.
- Bring your own hand sanitiser
- Cover your coughs and sneezes with your elbow
- There should be no off-court gatherings. Get in, play and get out.

## **Club Rooms**

The Club Rooms will not be open and toilet facilities will not be available.

## **Non Tennis Players**

Only people playing or participating in coaching are to be at the venue.
